“Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, was one of the two who heard what John [the Baptist] had said and who had followed Jesus. - The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, *We have found the Messiah (that is, the Christ)*. And he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, You are Simon, son of John. You will be called Cephas (which, when translated, is Peter).”
